



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE TALBOT HILL SANITARY SEWER RELOCATION

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) is moving forward on their I-405, SR 167 Interchange / Direct Connect Project. For this project, WSDOT is widening their right-of-way, which will move South 14th Street to the south. The existing utilities in the current South 14th Street will need to be relocated to the new road. The City of Renton's sanitary sewers will be the first utility to be moved.

Beginning mid-June, the City of Renton Wastewater Utility will be relocating sanitary sewer lines on Talbot Hill between South 14th Street and South 15th Street (see vicinity map on back).


As part of the City's Talbot Hill Sanitary Sewer Relocation Project, the contractor, Scarsella Brothers, will be directional drilling a deep sewer east/west in along the new road; installing shallow sewers in the new road to intercept the existing lines flowing to the north; and rough grading the road in preparation for future work by other agencies. Following our work, there will be other utility relocation work done by private utilities and work by WSDOT's design build contractor.

The construction of the new sewer main will take place this summer and fall. It is anticipated that work will begin mid-June and be completed by the end of December.
